- Camera ready paper submission: one week after acceptance letter
- Registration: 1st August 2024

Publication of contribution

Research papers and results with the subject area LCL shall take precedence. All contributions must be reviewed and evaluated by members of the LCL Workshop Scientific Council.

All papers to be published in Special issue of online ESS journal by TU Chemnitz.


